

# *From Father Simon*



*“As life starts moving faster and faster, we need to make a choice – to move faster with it or to step off every now and then, to marvel at the wonders around us, to take in new sights and sounds and remember just how beautiful life can be. This fall let us take in a big deep breath...”* These are words from a radio commercial inviting us to experience the beauty of the season of fall.


As nature puts on a show of color and we watch leaves fluttering to the ground during these days, we are reminded that nature's cycles are mirrored in our lives. Fall shows us how beautiful it is to let go of dead things. It is in our nature to grow attached to things, but what if the trees held so tightly to their leaves that they did not let them change their colors and fly? They would be holding on to something that, regardless of whether they held on or not, would eventually crumble. The funeral of the leaves is one of the most beautiful dances, and how courageous of the tree to strip itself bare to set them free. With each instance of letting go, the opportunity arises to strengthen, self-liberate, refresh and start over—to make room for a clean slate and to receive something new.

Fall reminds us of the impermanence of everything. We have experienced the budding of life in spring and the flowerings and profusions of summer. Now the leaves fall and bare branches remind us of the fleeting nature of all things. The changing leaves display so well how beautiful life can be when you leave your comfort zone. There is a certain beauty in forsaking familiarity in favor of foreign. There is a certain freedom in forfeiting whatever may have you rooted in favor of a new adventure. Fall also brings home to our consciousness death and the challenge to live every day to the fullest. So as the days get darker and colder take time to wonder, to reflect and to remember and know that there is no better place to do this than in our beautiful basilica. I look forward to seeing you at Mass.

*A word about our sound system:* Last year when we were making enhancements to our sound system, the audio consultants told us that the column speakers on either side of the altar have a couple more years of life in them. So we held off on phase two of the sound system update. However, last week one of the speakers that was repaired six years ago, finally gave up the ghost. We are implementing the final phase of the sound system update which began last Thanksgiving. This phase will address clarity of sound in the front half of the basilica and the side transepts. Our goal is that the work will be completed by Thanksgiving. We appreciate your patience while we complete this final phase.



If you held a mirror up to your life, would it reflect God's love and mercy? If you are struggling with this, try changing your attitude from "I want more" to "thank you God for everything you have given me, I have enough to share". This change in perspective will bring you joy through service to others.

### It's Our Turn

Unless you were here in the late 1950s when our church was under construction (see picture on right) you might think our Basilica was always here and always will be.

**But we know that it took a lot of hard work and a lot of very generous giving to fund our magnificent church, from people just like us, who sat in the same pews we sit in today.**

The financial challenge faced by those who came before us was to construct our parish buildings. **Our challenge today is to maintain and enhance those buildings.** As you decide on your level of support for our parish, please consider:

- Our parish capital campaign construction project is fully underway, with the comprehensive renovation and repurposing of our former convent, the Benedict Center. **Please keep current on your pledge so that our project can stay on schedule, and consider whether your circumstances might allow you to increase your earlier pledge.**
- Repair and maintenance costs for the Basilica especially have risen dramatically in recent years, including the unexpected replacement of the ceiling and the current work on the Bell Tower. **We were forced to borrow from our savings to pay for these repairs and will need your increased Sunday collections to replenish our savings.**

Whatever your decision, please know that we are always grateful for your full participation, including your attendance at Mass, your volunteer work in our many ministries, and your financial support.

## **The Sacrament of Baptism**

Queen of All Saints rejoices in the incorporation of new members into the Body of Christ through the Sacrament of Baptism. If you are a registered parishioner, please come to the rectory during business hours to schedule your child's baptism. If it is not possible for you to come to the rectory, please call the rectory to make arrangements. The Sacrament of Baptism for infants is celebrated two or three Sundays of the month, depending on the time of year, at 1:30pm. Please call the rectory for the exact schedule. A Baptismal Preparation class for the parents is required. They are held once a month on alternate Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and must also be scheduled in advance. If an adult or a school age child seeks baptism, special arrangements should be made with one of the priests.

## **The Sacrament of Matrimony**

Queen of All Saints helps couples prepare not only for their wedding day, but also for the lifelong commitment of living a Christian marriage. Parishioners of Queen of All Saints Basilica who are baptized and free to marry in the Catholic Church may celebrate their marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica. Couples from Queen of All Saints seeking marriage in Queen of All Saints Basilica should contact one of the parish priests at least six months prior to their intended date of marriage. The couple must meet with one of the priests before the date for the marriage can be confirmed.

## **Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick**

The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick is not just a sacrament for those who are at the point of death. As soon as one of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him or her to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived. Therefore, any member of the faithful who is seriously ill because of sickness or advanced age may properly receive this sacrament.
